The **Ministry of Northern Development, Mines, Natural Resources and Forestry** (NDMNRF) wants your input to confirm if the land uses (e.g., wildlife-friendly farming, hunting, hiking, scientific research, environmental education, and nature appreciation) in the Aylmer, Fingal and Calton Swamp Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) remain relevant and effective.



## About the WMAs

These WMAs are designated as Provincial Wildlife Areas. They are managed for wildlife and to provide opportunities for outdoor recreation, such as hunting and watching wildlife.
